The Diocese Walks the Ruins

A delegation from CNI Bombay Diocese recently visited the site to assess the full extent of damage and explore the path toward restoration. Church leaders, community representatives, and local stakeholders gathered at the ruins — united by a shared commitment to revive this mission.

Intent Without Resources

The visit signals the Diocese's clear intent to act. The will is present. The community is ready. But action on this scale requires substantial resources — and that is why we are reaching out to you.

□ The Diocese is committed to transparency. Funds received will be directed exclusively to the restoration of the Dahanu Hospital compound.

Inside the Ruins: What Was Lost

"Every room tells the story of a functioning hospital that served real patients — now silenced."

The Casualty Ward

Once the first point of care for emergency patients arriving in crisis, the Casualty ward now lies in rubble. Its signboard remains visible amid the debris — a haunting reminder of the lives this ward once touched.

Frozen in Time

Medical furniture, shelving, and ward equipment remain scattered across collapsed floors — not removed, not replaced, simply abandoned. The hospital did not close — it fell.
